1) **Rules:** The regatta will be governed by the racing rules established by the CCWBRA, except as may be amended by race officials at the event. All weight regulations will apply.

2) **Eligibility:** There will be starts for the following classes provided that there are 3 registered boats per class. If a given class does not have a minimum of 3 boats registered then the Race Committee, at its sole discretion, can combine classes giving preference to the classes with the most people registered. Classic and Open 6hp categories are not mixed and will not run in the same heat.

Classic 6hp-Pre 1976-Womans Division, Open Division, Heavyweight Division (2 cycle)

Classic 6hp- 1976-1979-Woman's Division, Open Division, Heavyweight Division (2 Cycle)

Post 1979 6hp- Woman's Division, Open Division, Heavyweight Division (2 or 4 cycle).

Open 8hp- Open registration

3) **Schedule of Events:** Heat racing, no more than 6 boats per heat.

4) **Registration and Fees:** CCWBRA requests that all entrants pre-register online via the CCWBRA website. The driver registration fee is \$30 until July8. The registration after the 8th will be \$40. Lunch is included in the registration fee for each driver. On-site registration and check-in will begin on 16th from 8:00 am until

10:00 am at the registration table. Each racer must be a member of CCWBRA to race. Annual membership is \$25. See payment options online at www.ccwbra.com or become a member at registration.

- 5) Scoring: Low point scoring system shown in CCWBRA handbook will apply.
- 6) **Awards:** Ribbons for first, second, and third places in each class.
- 7) **Facilities:** There is a boat ramp on site. Boats can also be carried to the water. The KIYC has a clubhouse with bathrooms. Food will be available at the clubhouse (lunch is included in the registration fee for each driver).
- 8) **Risk**: All competitors are ultimately responsible for the inherent risks associated with boat racing. It is the competitor's decision to enter the regatta and to start and continue any race. Each competitor will accept full responsibility for all of their actions during any activity related to the event. This includes on shore activities before, during and after the activity.
