- **Note 1** Driver weight must meet minimum weight requirement. In all other classes, driver may ballast-up using water jugs, etc.
- Classes may be combined or eliminated depending on the number of drivers in each class.
- A driver may only compete in one race per engine category. If the participant has a 6 HP Classic engine and a 6 HP Post-1979 engine, he/she may race in both engine classes.
- There will be 15 minutes between racing classes for driver change outs with a half hour between the 8 and 6 HP classes for engine change outs.
- Drivers racing in the Championship Heat must race in the same boat they qualified in.

Special Notes Regarding this Event

• **Note 1** - All boats must have a CCWBRA 2019 Safety Inspection Sticker to be eligible to race. See the 2019 Rule Book for safety requirements.

- All race participants must sign in at the Registration Desk on the day of the race and weigh in even if they are pre-registered.
- Each class will race qualifying heats and a championship heat. Each heat will consist of three races. The number of qualifying heats will be based on the number of registered drivers for that class with each heat limited to no more than 6 boats. Each Championship Heat will consist of the top 6 finishers from the qualifying heats.
- A minimum of three drivers will be required to run a racing class. If there are not sufficient drivers in one class they will race with the mixed class for that HP group. Engine classes will not be mixed.
- All drivers are expected to review and abide by the 2019 edition of the CCWBRA's Racing and Safety Handbook
 and any supplemental updates, understand racing procedures and come equipped with the required safety
 equipment. The Handbook may be found at www.ccwbra.com. These rules may be modified by race officials at
 this race event. Race participants will be notified at the Drivers' Meeting of any changes to these rules.
- Scoring: The low point scoring system as shown in the CCWBRA Racing Handbook will apply.
- Awards: Ribbons for First, Second, and Third places will be given in each class.
- Risk: All competitors are ultimately responsible for the inherent risks associated with boat racing. It is the
 competitor's decision to enter this regatta and to start or conclude any race. Each competitor will accept full
 responsibility for his/her actions during any activity related to the event. This includes on-shore activities before,
 during and after the regatta.
- Race schedule subject to change.
