- Note 1 Driver weight must meet minimum weight requirement.
- Classes may be combined or eliminated depending on the number of drivers in each class.
- A driver may only compete in one race per engine category. If the participant has a 6 HP Classic engine and a 6 HP Post-1979 engine, he/she may race in both engine classes.
- Each heat will last approximately 15 minutes.
- There will be 15 minutes between racing classes for driver change outs with a half hour between the 8 and 6 HP classes for engine change outs.
- Drivers racing in the Championship Heat must race in the same boat they qualified in.

\* All boats must have a CCWBRA 2019 Safety Inspection Sticker to be eligible to race. All CCWBRA Safety Requirements apply, including orange full cut helmet and orange PFD. See the current CCWBRA Rule Book for safety requirements. Registration and Safety Inspections will be open to all classes on Friday, May 17<sup>th</sup>. All classes may register and get inspected on Saturday May 18<sup>st</sup> from 8-9:00 am, however earliest racing classes will be given priority.

- **REGISTRATION & FEES:** The CCWBRA requests that all entrants pre-register online via <a href="www.ccwbra.com">www.ccwbra.com</a>. On-site registration and check-in will begin on Friday the 17<sup>th</sup> from 4-6pm or Saturday the 18<sup>th</sup> from 8-9am at the registration desk. There will be an additional \$10 fee for on-site registration. Each race must be a member of CCWBRA to race. Annual membership is \$25. See payment options online at <a href="www.ccwbra.com">www.ccwbra.com</a> or become a member at registration.
- **NO WAKE RESTRICTION** in Urbanna Harbor is temporarily suspended on Friday May 17<sup>th</sup> from 2pm-sunset and on Saturday May 19<sup>th</sup> from sunrise to sunset. All other times the NO WAKE area will be in effect and strictly enforced.
- Each class will race qualifying heats and a championship heat. Each heat will consist of three races. The number of qualifying heats will be based on the number of registered drivers for that class with each heat limited to no more than 6 boats. Each Championship Heat will consist of the top 6 finishers from the qualifying heats.
- A minimum of three drivers will be required to run a racing class. If there are not sufficient drivers in one class they will race with the mixed class for that HP group. Engine classes will not be mixed.
- All drivers are expected to review and abide by the latest edition of the CCWBRA's Racing and Safety Handbook and
  any supplemental updates, understand racing procedures, and come equipped with the required safety equipment.
  The Handbook may be found at <a href="https://www.ccwbra.com">www.ccwbra.com</a>. These rules may be modified by race officials at this race event.
  Race participants will be notified at the Drivers' Meeting of any changes to these rules.
