All Drivers are expected to review and abide by the 2019 edition of the CCWBRA's Racing and Safety Handbook any supplemental updates, understand the racing procedures and come equipped with the required safety equipment. The handbook may be found at www.cwbra.com. These rules may be modified by race officials at this race event. Skippers will be notified of any changes at the skippers meeting.

The Race Committee and Race Director(s) will determine whether the wind and wave conditions are suitable for racing per CCWBRA Racing Handbook 2019 edition

Risk: All Competitors are ultimately responsible for the inherent risks associated with boat racing. It is the competitor's decision to enter this regatta and to start or conclude any race. Each competitor will accept full responsibility for his/her actions during ANY activity related to this event. This includes on-shore activities before, during and after the regatta (race).

All boats must have a CCWBRA 2021 Safety Inspection Sticker to be eligible to race. See CCWBRA Racing Handbook 2019 edition for safety requirements

All race participants must sign in with the racing officials on the day of the race and weigh in, even if they have pre-registered

Classes may be combined or eliminated depending on the number of drivers in each class.

Race Schedule is subject to change due to racing conditions, safety or to allow better flow to the race day. See the Race director if you have any questions or concerns.

Awards: First, Second and Third will be given in each class

A Driver may only compete in one race per engine category

Drivers racing in the Championship Heat "Finals" must race the same boat they qualified in.

Camping is permitted on the RHYC grounds. Both RV and Tents. Contact a club manager for specific areas they would like you to be at. Or see Race Director.
